Depending on the number of people on the course we aim to be finished by 3pm. Please bring along some money for your entry fee (£22 Chepstow), your log book, swimwear, some warm clothing and money for any extra air you use (£5/tank) and food & beverages.

#### **Directions**

**From M4 to Junction 15 -** Take M4 towards South Wales - Turn onto the M48 towards Chepstow and Services - Cross the Severn and Wye Bridges and turn off at Junction 2 - Take the second exit A466 towards Chepstow and Tintern - Turn right onto the A48 at the next roundabout and continue into Chepstow. Continue through Chepstow on the A48 towards Gloucester, the National Diving & Activity Centre is 1.2 miles outside Chepstow on the left hand side.
