



Dear Diver, thank you for booking your Discover Scuba experience with us.

Please download and complete the [PADI Liability forms, Statement of Safe Diving Practices](#) and [PADI Medical Forms](#) and bring them with you on the day. Please note that [if you answer 'yes' to questions 3, 5 or 10, or any of the questions on page 2 of the medical statement then we would need a note from your doctor saying that you are okay to dive.](#) **If you answer 'yes' and do not have a note from your GP or Diving Medic, then your instructor is not allowed to let you dive.** No note is required if you answer 'no'.

Discover scuba diving is ideal for experiencing the joys of scuba diving in the safety of a heated swimming pool. It's designed for people who either want to try a new adventure or if they're not sure if they want to commit to the PADI Open Water certification course.

The experience will teach you some of the basic principles of scuba, the most important safety rules and how the equipment works. You will get to feel what it's like to breathe underwater and be weightless. After spending some time in the shallow end getting comfortable and familiar with the equipment and the strange sensations, we will head to the deep end where you get to swim around underwater.

**Timings:**

12:30 to 13:00 – Registration at the side entrance to the pool

Please don't change or enter the pool until you have signed in.

13:00 to 13:30 – Poolside briefing

13:30 to 14:30 – In-water training

**What to bring** to the pool – PADI forms, swimwear, towel, and your sense of adventure.

It's also a good idea to bring a bottle of water as diving can make you thirsty. If you wear contact lenses these can be worn inside your mask but just keep your eyes closed when doing the mask skills!

## St. John's Beaumont School Swimming Pool



**Address:** Priest Hill, Old Windsor, Berkshire SL4 2JN

**Directions:** The school has close proximity to the M3, M4, M25 and M40 motorways, and is only six miles from London Heathrow Airport. The nearest train station is Egham which has a frequent service to Waterloo (approximately 40 minutes).

**By Car:** St John's is on Priest Hill (A328) just off the A308 two miles from the M25 (J13) and seven miles from the M4 (J6). The school is about 500 yards up the hill on the right.

**By Rail:** The nearest station is Egham which is on the line to Waterloo via Twickenham, Putney and Clapham Junction. We are 10 minutes by taxi from Egham station.

**About St. Johns:** St John's, the oldest purpose built preparatory school in the country and founded in 1888, combines a rich tradition of education with the very best that modern teaching techniques and technology can offer. It was designed by John Francis Bentley, one of the most famous architects of his day and the architect of Westminster Cathedral in London. Boys leave St John's aged 13 and proceed to some of the country's finest schools.

**Parking:** There is plenty of free parking by the tennis courts on the right hand side before you reach the barrier.

**The Pool:** Situated at the top of the hill in front of the school in a modern building. There are changing rooms for men and women. The pool itself is 25m long, has a maximum depth of 2m and is heated to 30 degrees.
