

Dear Diver,



Many thanks for signing up to the PADI Advanced Open Water course with us.

Please read this document carefully as it contains valuable information for your course.

The Advanced Open Water course will qualify you to dive to 30m, make you a better & safer diver and teach you exciting new skills. There are five 'Adventure Dives' which include a **Deep** and **Navigation** dive, due to the local diving conditions we will do 3 of the following dives:

- **Peak Performance Buoyancy or Dry Suit** – this will help you be a much better diver and means that you get to see more and make your air last longer. Or the dry suit course is useful if you wish to dive in the UK year-round or you want to stay warmer in the water. This is mandatory in the winter months
- **Wreck** – there are several interesting wrecks at the dive site including planes, boats and helicopters
- **SMB (surface marker buoy)** – this simple yet lifesaving piece of equipment requires some practice to master.

If you would prefer to do a different Adventure dive to those listed above (such as photography if you own your own underwater camera), then we would be happy to try and accommodate you. A list of these can be found in the e-manual you will receive.

Theory

You should receive your Advanced Open Water Diver online learning code within 2 working days of booking the course. If you don't receive it then please check your spam folder before letting us know. For the start of the course could you please read the sections that correspond to the adventure dives you are doing (above) and complete the knowledge reviews found at the end of each section. You don't need to read the whole manual but some divers enjoy reading about the other types of adventures dives.

Typically it takes around 4-5 hours to complete the theory depending on how many sessions you break it up in to. Please don't leave it until the last minute!

What to bring

- The PADI Medical Statement which can be found [here](#). Please note that if you answer 'yes' to any of the medical questions **on PAGE 2 then** we require a COPY of a note from your GP saying that you are fit to dive.
- The PADI Liability Form, which can be found [here](#).
- The e-learning record showing you have completed the theory
- Your open water (or equivalent) certification card
- Log book
- Money for entry fees to the lake (£15 - 23 per day), air fills (£5 each – CASH ONLY), food and drinks

Dives

Your instructor will meet you at Mercers Country Park at 9.30am on the Saturday and then 10.00am at St. Andrews Lake (unless otherwise told) on the Sunday, and we aim to finish around 3pm both days. If you are doing your course with us in either July or August the Sunday dives will take place at Vobster Quay instead of St. Andrews.

The entry fee (£15) for Mercers Park is payable on arrival by card. Your entry fee to St. Andrews will need to be paid in cash on Sunday to your instructor.

For Vobster we have to book a number of school spaces and you will receive a link from us to Vobster's payment site to pay your entry fees (£23) and confirm to them you are coming. This will also have the meeting time so please ensure you read this carefully as there are 2 slots available at the lake – 9am to 2pm, and 2pm to 8pm (we book the earlier slot whenever possible).

You can find directions to the lakes attached (below).

The 5 adventures dives will be split across both days.

If you are doing your dives in one of our 7mm wetsuits (May to November) then you will need swimwear, towel and a change of warm clothing.

If you have booked to do it in a dry suit or complete the course between December and April, then please bring along some warm and thin items to wear underneath the dry suit as well as normal swimwear. Thermals are ideal but if you don't have them then sweatshirt / warm leggings / tracksuit bottoms will suffice.

If you have any of your own equipment such as mask and fins then please feel free to bring them along.

Accommodation

Most people go home after the lake dive on Saturday but if you are doing the course in July or August in Vobster then you may wish to drive to Vobster after the Mercers Lake session. There is lots of accommodation close by but we tend to stay at the Premier Inn Frome Hotel which is approx. an 18 minute drive.

Once you have completed your course then you will receive your e-certification card the following week. If you are planning on diving within a day or two then please let your instructor know so we can fast track your certification. You will also be registered on the global PADI database so every PADI centre can find your certification assuming they have internet.

As you will be qualified to dive to 30m we recommend that you consider getting your own dive computer. You are welcome to call the office on 0800 699 0243, view our [online store](#) or speak to your instructor during the weekend. The lake is surrounded by a country park with green forests that dog walkers and families are free to enjoy. Our partners at Aqua Sports have given us EXCLUSIVITY ON DIVING to the lake, so you won't find lots of other dive schools here fighting for platforms or stirring up the bottom.

Divers benefit from clear waters, with visibility normally in excess of 8m. The lake is surrounded by an underwater forest which is home to tonnes of fish including perch, pike, bream and giant carp. We are still discovering new and exciting parts of the lake but our explorations have found an average depth of around 8m with a maximum depth of 15m.

We will meet you by our van at the top of the slip way at the time shown on the top of your booking confirmation and receipt (normally 9am). One of our instructors will give you a site briefing before starting your course.

The Cafe is currently selling hot & cold drinks as well as snacks such as ice creams and crisps. However we recommend you bring a flask with your own hot drinks as well as any food you wish to consume. If you could take your rubbish home it would really help our team!

The lake is perfectly located between the M25 and M23, with easy access from London and Gatwick Airport

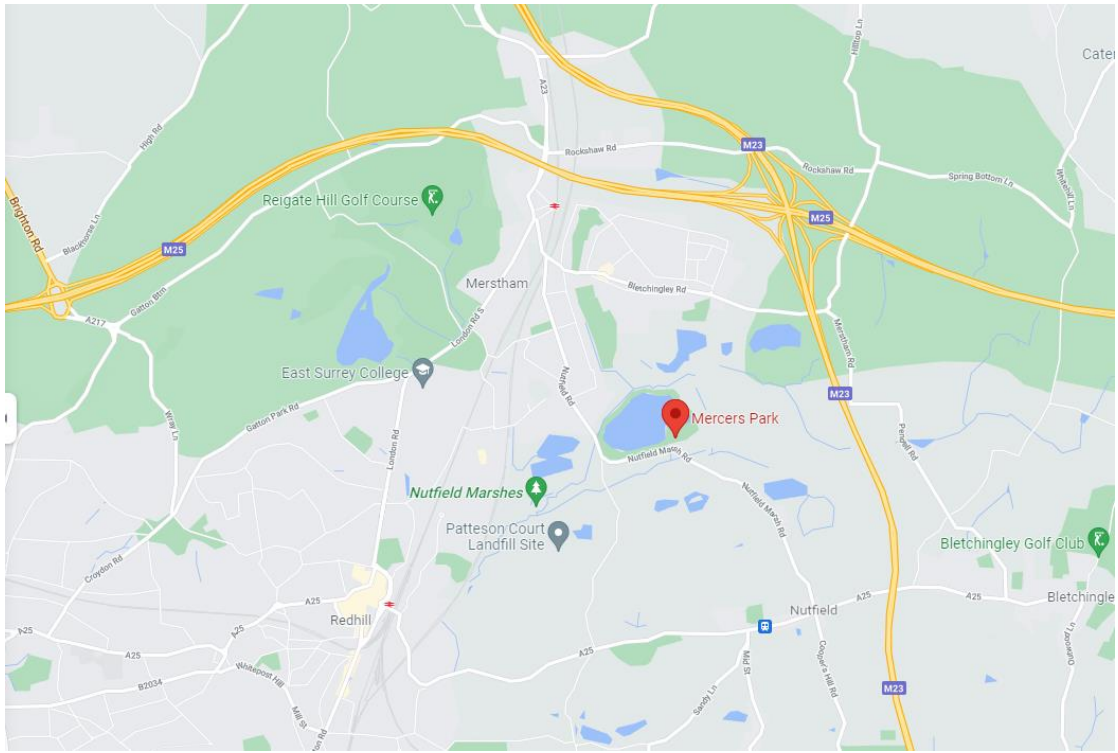
Nearest Rail Stations: Merstham or Redhill (direct from London Victoria)

Bus: Take to 430 from Redhill bus station Platform 4 to Mill Lane in Merstham (opposite Watercolours Housing) then it's a 12 minute walk around the lake.

- Warm clothes for in between dives or for under your drysuit
- Sun protection if it is a sunny day
- Towel / robe
- Log book
- Any equipment not hired from us
- Money for entry fee (£15 payable on arrival and £5 for subsequent air fills)
