



### PADI REACTIVATE COURSE DETAILS AND ADDRESS

Many thanks for signing up to your PADI ReActivate refresher course with us, we greatly appreciate it! Please read the information below carefully.

On the PADI E-learning page under "Forms & Applications" Please complete the **PADI Liability forms**. **Statement of Safe Diving Practices and PADI Medical Forms** and bring them with you on the day either digitally or printed.

Please note that <u>if you answer 'yes' to questions 3, 5 or 10, or any of the questions on page 2 of the medical statement, you are required to get page 3 completed by a medical professional.</u> If you answer 'yes' and do not have a note from a medical professional, your instructor is not allowed to let you dive.

### Theory

You will receive your PADI e-learning, by e-mail directly from PADI within two working days of signing up to your course (please check your Junk Mail if you haven't received it before contacting us). Once received you can register it using your e-mail address, but if you already have a PADI account you should see it linked to that. Each individual diver must have an individual account.

Please make sure to upload a photo of yourself at registration if one doesn't appear, this is required by PADI to process for your certification.

Please complete all sections before the pool session.

Please bring a digital or printed copy of your "eRecord" and forms to the pool session and hand it to your instructor. If you have any technical difficulties then PADI customer services will be glad to assist, you can call them on 0117 300 7234.











## **Pool dives**

## Timings:

12:00 to 12:30 – Arrival and change. Please come directly to the poolside.

12:30 to 13:00 - Pool side briefing and equipment set up.

13:00 to 15:00 - In-water training

15:00 to 15:30 – Log book completion with the instructor

Please refer to our terms and conditions if you need to change your booking.

As well as they key theoretical elements being covered online, the practical part covers things like how to set up your equipment correctly and check it, mask clearing, buoyancy control and air monitoring / out-of-air procedures.

**What to bring** to the pool – PADI forms (printed or Digital), e-learning scores, swimwear, towel, and any diving equipment you may own (we will have everything there anyway so don't worry if you don't).

It's also a good idea to bring a bottle of water as diving can make you thirsty. If you wear contact lenses these can be worn inside your mask but just keep your eyes closed when doing the mask skills! You can order a mask with prescription lenses at an additional cost, please just get in touch if you would like further details.

If you haven't done so already, we do recommend purchasing a mask, snorkel, boots, and fins. These are available through our <u>dive shop</u> and can be delivered to your address or the pool.

If you own any of your own equipment such as mask, snorkel and fins, please feel free to bring it along. If you don't have any of your own gear then we will provide everything for you. From our experience rental masks around the world tend to be poor quality and leak, so we would always recommend having your own mask including ones with prescription lenses, and if you are thinking of doing several dives on holiday then possibly even a <u>dive computer</u> to keep you safe. You can <u>visit our online store</u> for details and they can be bought to your pool session for you to use on the day.

We receive many questions about "Should I own my own equipment" so to make it easy we have written a short blog to help you.

# SOUTH EAST LONDON AND KENT Swimming Pool



**Driveway access to house** 

Address: 54 Weald Way, Caterham, Surrey, CR3 6EJ

The image above is the view from the road of the driveway. Please turn in here. The purpose built dive pool is located in the grounds of a private residence. If the right hand gate is open then please park at the top of the lane, otherwise you may park in front of the house.

**Directions:** The house is located close to the M20 and M25.

**By Car:** Exit M25 at Junction 6 and take the turning towards Caterham. Continue towards Caterham until you reach Morrisons Supermarket, turn left here followed by the next left up Harestone Valley Road. Continue along here for approximately one mile past Caterham School and turn left at Weald Way. The house is Number 54 and can be found on the left hand side around the sharp bend. Please take care when leaving the property!

**By Rail:** The nearest station is Caterham which is on the line to Waterloo. It is approximately a 20 minute walk from the station.

**Parking:** There is plenty of free parking outside the property. Your instructor will meet you on poolside. Please follow the 'The Way To the Beach' signs.
