Many thanks for signing up to your PADI ReActivate refresher course with us, we greatly appreciate it! Please read the information below carefully.

On the PADI E-learning page under "Forms & Applications" Please complete the **PADI Liability forms, Statement of Safe Diving Practices and PADI Medical Forms** and bring them with you on the day either digitally or printed.

Please note that if you answer 'yes' to questions 3, 5 or 10, or any of the questions on page 2 of the medical statement, you are required to get page 3 completed by a medical professional. **If you answer 'yes' and do not have a note from a medical professional, your instructor is not allowed to let you dive.**

Theory

You will receive your PADI e-learning, by e-mail directly from PADI within two working days of signing up to your course (please check your Junk Mail if you haven't received it before contacting us). Once received you can register it using your e-mail address, but if you already have a PADI account you should see it linked to that. Each individual diver must have an individual account.

Please make sure to upload a photo of yourself at registration if one doesn't appear, this is required by PADI to process for your certification.

Please complete all sections before the pool session.

Please bring a digital or printed copy of your "eRecord" and forms to the pool session and hand it to your instructor. If you have any technical difficulties then PADI customer services will be glad to assist, you can call them on 0117 300 7234.

14:00 to 14:30 – Arrival and change. Please come directly to the poolside.

14:30 to 15:00 – Pool side briefing and equipment set up.

15:00 to 16:00 – In-water training

16:00 to 16:30 – Log book completion with the instructor

As well as the key theoretical elements being covered online, the practical part covers things like how to set up your equipment correctly and check it, mask clearing, buoyancy control and air monitoring / out-of-air procedures.

What to bring to the pool – PADI forms (printed or Digital), e-learning scores, swimwear, towel, and any diving equipment you may own (we will have everything there anyway so don't worry if you don't).

It's also a good idea to bring a bottle of water as diving can make you thirsty. If you wear contact lenses these can be worn inside your mask but just keep your eyes closed when doing the mask skills! You can order a mask with prescription lenses at an additional cost, please just get in touch if you would like further details.

If you haven't done so already, we do recommend purchasing a mask, snorkel, boots, and fins. These are available through our [dive shop](#) and can be delivered to your address or the pool.

If you own any of your own equipment such as mask, snorkel and fins, please feel free to bring it along. If you don't have any of your own gear then we will provide everything for you. From our experience rental masks around the world tend to be poor quality and leak, so we would always recommend having your own mask including ones with prescription lenses, and if you are thinking of doing several dives on holiday then possibly even a [dive computer](#) to keep you safe. You can [visit our online store](#) for details and they can be bought to your pool session for you to use on the day.

St. John's Beaumont School Swimming Pool



Address: Priest Hill, Old Windsor, Berkshire SL4 2JN

Directions: The school is within close proximity to the M3, M4, M25 and M40 motorways, and is only six miles from London Heathrow Airport. The nearest train station is Egham which has a frequent service to Waterloo (approximately 40 minutes).

By Car: St John's is on Priest Hill (A328) just off the A308 two miles from the M25 (J13) and seven miles from the M4 (J6). The school is about 500 yards up the hill on the right.

By Rail: The nearest station is Egham which is on the line to Waterloo via Twickenham, Putney and Clapham Junction. We are 10 minutes by taxi from Egham station.

About St. Johns: St John's, the oldest purpose built preparatory school in the country and was founded in 1888, it combines a rich tradition of education with the very best that modern teaching techniques and technology can offer. It was designed by John Francis Bentley, one of the most famous architects of his day and the architect of Westminster Cathedral in London. Boys leave St John's aged 13 and proceed to some of the country's finest schools.

Parking: There is plenty of free parking by the tennis courts on the right hand side before you reach the barrier. Please park here and then walk up the hill.

The Pool: Situated at the top of the hill in front of the school in a modern building. Please enter by the side entrance where your instructor will meet you. There are changing rooms for men and women and you are welcome to leave your valuables pool side (at your own risk). The pool itself is 25m long, has a maximum depth of 2m and is heated to 30 degrees.
