

EMERGENCY OXYGEN PROVIDER

The course will cover details such assembling and disassembling emergency oxygen equipment, deploying a no-rebreather mask and a demand inhalator valve on a breathing diver, using a pocket mask on a nonbreathing diver, and more.

Some warm clothes as we often run the course outside as would be done in a real emergency and the completed e-learning summary. There is no pool or open water work involved, so please be sure to dress appropriately for the location you are taking the course.
