Your PADI Advanced Open Water Course – Important Information

Thank you for booking your PADI Advanced Open Water course with Oyster Diving. This course is designed to help you become a more confident, capable diver, while expanding your depth limits and unlocking access to more exciting dive sites.

Please read the information below carefully, as it contains everything you need to prepare for your training.

The Course:

The Advanced Open Water course qualifies you to dive to 30 metres and focuses on building confidence, improved safety, and unlocking more dive sites worldwide. It includes 5 Adventure Dives; Deep, Navigation and the 3 electives below:

- **Peak Performance Buoyancy** - this will help you fine-tune your buoyancy, so diving feels smoother, more controlled and easier, while improving efficiency and air consumption.
- **Intro to Rescue** - build confidence by learning how to spot small issues early and get an introduction to handling common dive problems calmly, keeping dives safe, relaxed, and enjoyable.
- **Wreck** - explore local wrecks such as aircraft and boats and discover what makes wreck diving so popular.

These dives are chosen to give you the best possible experience based on local conditions and dive sites.

Recommended Add-Ons (Discounted with Advanced)

- **Enriched Air (Nitrox)** – extended bottom times, reduce post-dive fatigue, and make longer dive days more comfortable.
- **Drysuit** – ideal for UK diving and allows you to dive more comfortably all year round

Your course would also be non-refundable at this stage.

Theory (eLearning)

Please complete the sections relating to your five Adventure Dives and finish the knowledge reviews at the end of each section.

Most students take around 3–4 hours in total. We strongly recommend not leaving this until the last minute.

Each day you will be given a wristband at check-in and all purchases made will be added to a tab on the number. At the end of each session, you must pay your tab directly to the Vobster shop.

Once you have completed your course you will receive your e-certification card the following week.
