Medical Questionnaire - IMPORTANT: If you answer 'Yes' to questions **3, 5, or 10** on page 1, or to any questions on page 2 of the medical statement, you will need a signed note from your doctor confirming you are fit to dive. Without this note, your instructor is not allowed to let you dive. If you answer 'No' to all questions, then no GP note is required.

If you have any problems with the forms, we will have spares available on the day. Your instructor may also ask you to show your completed forms within the PADI App under 'Digital Forms' in the E-Learning Portal.

- Bottle of water (diving can make you thirsty)
- Contact lenses can be worn inside your mask – just remember to close your eyes during mask-removal skills

On Arrival

When you arrive at the pool, one of our PADI Instructors will meet you at reception. They'll check your paperwork, including your [medical statement](#), and show you to the changing rooms and pool.

You will then spend the first 20 minutes or so in the shallow end learning to use the gear, getting used to breathing underwater and doing a few basic safety skills which are also found in the [PADI Open Water certification](#) course.

The image above is the view from the road of the driveway. The purpose-built dive pool is in the grounds of a private residence. If the right-hand gate is open then please park at the top of the lane, otherwise you may park in front of the house.

Directions: The house is located close to the M20 and M25.

By Car: Exit M25 at Junction 6 and take the turning towards Caterham. Continue towards Caterham until you reach Morrisons Supermarket, turn left here followed by the next left up Harestone Valley Road. Continue along here for approximately one-mile past Caterham School and turn left at Weald Way. The house is Number 54 and can be found on the left-hand side around the sharp bend. Please take care when leaving the property!

By Rail: The nearest station is Caterham which is on the line to Waterloo. It is approximately a 20-minute walk from the station.

Parking: There is plenty of free parking outside the property. Your instructor will meet you poolside. Please follow the 'The Way to the Beach' signs.
