Medical Questionnaire - IMPORTANT: If you answer 'Yes' to questions **3, 5, or 10** on page 1, or to any questions on page 2 of the medical statement, you will need a signed note from your doctor confirming you are fit to dive. Without this note, your instructor is not allowed to let you dive. If you answer 'No' to all questions, then no GP note is required.

If you have any problems with the forms, we will have spares available on the day. Your instructor may also ask you to show your completed forms within the PADI App under 'Digital Forms' in the E-Learning Portal.

What to Bring

- Completed forms
- Swimwear and towel
- Small padlock for lockers (available at reception for a small fee if you don't have one)
- Bottle of water (diving can make you thirsty)
- Contact lenses can be worn inside your mask – just remember to close your eyes during mask-removal skills

On Arrival

When you arrive at the pool, one of our PADI Instructors will meet you at reception. They'll check your paperwork, including your [medical statement](#), and show you to the changing rooms and pool.

You will then spend the first 20 minutes or so in the shallow end learning to use the gear, getting used to breathing underwater and doing a few basic safety skills which are also found in the [PADI Open Water certification](#) course.

Address: Priest Hill, Old Windsor, Berkshire SL4 2JN

Directions: The school has close proximity to the M3, M4, M25 and M40 motorways, and is only six miles from London Heathrow Airport. The nearest train station is Egham which has a frequent service to Waterloo (approximately 40 minutes).

By Car: St John's is on Priest Hill (A328) just off the A308 two miles from the M25 (J13) and seven miles from the M4 (J6). The school is about 500 yards up the hill on the right.

By Rail: The nearest station is Egham which is on the line to Waterloo via Twickenham, Putney and Clapham Junction. We are 10 minutes by taxi from Egham station.

About St. Johns: St John's, the oldest purpose-built preparatory school in the country and founded in 1888, combines a rich tradition of education with the very best that modern teaching techniques and technology can offer. It was designed by John Francis Bentley, one of the most famous architects of his day and the architect of Westminster Cathedral in London. Boys leave St John's aged 13 and proceed to some of the country's finest schools.

Parking: There is plenty of free parking by the tennis courts on the right-hand side before you reach the barrier.

The Pool: Situated at the top of the hill in front of the school in a modern building. There are changing rooms for men and women. The pool itself is 25m long, has a maximum depth of 2m and is heated to 30 degrees.
