Before you come

Please complete the following before your session:

- Download the PADI App and register for a PADI account if you don't have one already.
- Complete your PADI ReActivate Digital eLearning before your pool session.
- Upload a photo during PADI registration, as this is required for certification.
- Print and complete the required PADI forms listed below.

Forms to complete

Form	What to do
Medical Questionnaire	Download, print, complete, and bring it with you.
Liability Release Form	Download, print, complete, and bring it with you.
Safe Diving Practices Form	Download, print, complete, and bring it with you.

Medical questionnaire - important

If you answer 'Yes' to questions 3, 5, or 10 on page 1, or to any question on page 2 of the medical statement, you must bring a signed note from your doctor confirming you are fit to dive. Without this, your instructor is not allowed to let you dive. If you answer 'No' to all questions, no GP note is required.

Course structure

Your ReActivate course has two parts:

1. **Theory:** PADI ReActivate Digital eLearning
2. **Pool session:** equipment setup, skills refresh, buoyancy control, and emergency procedures

1. Theory: eLearning

You will receive your PADI ReActivate Digital eLearning by email directly from PADI within 2 working days of signing up. Please check your junk or spam folder before contacting us.

Each diver should use their own PADI account, not that of a friend or family member. Please complete all sections before your pool session.

The eLearning works on a PC, Mac, or tablet. If using a tablet, you will need an internet connection to submit your scores. Phones can be used, but the small screen makes this less practical and is not recommended.

Bring a copy of your eRecord to the pool session and give it to your instructor. If you do not have a printer, [e-mail it to us](#) in advance and we can print it for you.

2. Pool session

We will meet you at the time stated at the top of your Booking Confirmation

During the pool session, your instructor will refresh core skills including equipment setup, buoyancy control, mask and regulator skills, and emergency procedures.

What to bring

- Completed PADI forms
- eLearning scores / eRecord
- Swimwear and towel
- Change of clothes
- Any personal diving equipment you own; we provide all required kit
- Bottle of water

Contact lenses can be worn inside your mask but a prescription mask is advisable if you need corrective lenses. [Masks with prescription lenses](#) are available at an additional cost; please contact us for details.

Address:

Brighton Swimming Centre, Eastern Road, Brighton, East Sussex, BN2 5JJ.

By Car:

From A23 - Approaching Brighton along the A23 drive south following signs to the City Centre. Pass St. Peter's Church on your right and continue to the traffic lights opposite the Royal Pavilion. Turn left at these lights on to Edward Street. Continue straight on and the road automatically becomes Eastern Road. Pass the Royal Sussex County Hospital Complex and the centre is 200m beyond this point on your left. Access is via Brighton College Pre Prep School's main gate.

From A259 (coast road) – Follow signs for the Royal Sussex County Hospital. If travelling from the West, pass the hospital and the centre is 200m beyond this point on your left. If travelling from the East the centre is 200m before the hospital complex on your right. Access is via Brighton College Pre Prep School's main gate.

Once on the grounds the swimming pool is sign posted.

Parking:



Parking is permitted on-site for swimming lessons from the late afternoon onwards – however this can be limited and we would advise parking on nearby streets first. Please be aware you park at your own risk, we can't be liable for any damage or theft. Parking is also allowed on the entrance road leading up to the swimming pool next to Brighton College on the below days:

Monday, Thursday, Friday: from 16:00

Tuesday: from 16:30

Saturday and Sunday: all day

If you can't find a space, there is on-street parking that is only a £1 for 1 hour. This is reasonable compared to other streets around Brighton. There is also Wilsons avenue in Whitehawk that is free, which is about a 10 minute walk to the centre.

By Train/Bus:

There is a bus stop directly outside the Centre's grounds and a number of services stop there: 1, 1A, 1B, 7, 14B, 14C, 25C, 37, 37B, 40X, 47, 52, 57, 71, 73, 90, 94A, N7, N99. Please be aware these may be subject to change.

The nearest train station to Brighton Swimming Centre is Brighton Station. From the station the number 7 bus stops directly outside the Centre.
